PENTECOST OFFERING

We will be collecting our annual Pentecost Offering NEXT *Sunday, May 19, 2024* This is one of the four Special Offerings collected each year to support the work of the Church. The focus of the Pentecost Offering is to enable the church to encourage, develop, and support its young people, and address the needs of atrisk children. 40% of the Pentecost offering is kept here to make an impact in the lives of young people within our community. The remaining 60% is used to support children-at-risk, youth, and young adults through ministries of the Presbyterian Mission Agency.

The Mission Agency uses their portion to support the Young Adult Volunteer (YAV) program, the Office of Presbyterian Youth and Triennium and the "Educate a Child, Transform the World" national initiative. We used our portion of the Pentecost offering last year to help support Camp Greentop, an empowering summer camp for children with disabilities


