MISSION

Celebrating 20 Years of Compañerismo: Sunday, September 29

You are cordially invited to join the celebration in Buck Hall after worship to commemorate the church's 20 years of covenant relationship with Presbiterio La Unión Maya Quiché Boca Costa. The festivities will include Guatemalan snacks and refreshments; two decades worth of photos, stories, and memories; an update on the activities of the compañerismo (partnership); and a video showing highlights of the recent trip that included three days of joyous celebrations with most of the presbytery's 1,600 members across eight churches.

Guatemala Scholarship Fundraising Campaign

Fundraising has begun for our Guatemala Scholarship Program. The goal is to continue funding 94 students in grades 7-12 and up to four university students in the school year that starts in January 2025. A full scholarship for grades 7-12 costs \$485 and a university scholarship costs \$1,000. All contributions are welcome; you don't have to fund an entire scholarship. Guatemala Stove Project Trip

A delegation will be traveling to Guatemala from January 16 – 21, 2025 to strengthen our partnership, develop relationships, and provide mission experience installing 36 Onil Stoves in homes of our partner presbytery's members. The trip is limited to 10 people. The cost will be in the range of \$1300 to \$1,400 /person, depending on airfare. An application and \$300 deposit check are required to be received no later than 12pm, Sunday, October 20th. This is a work trip involving physical labor and walking. Applicants must be at least 18 years of age. Applications are available at the welcome desk, church office or by emailing Brett Sivo. Applications may be turned in to the church office or placed in mail box 41. Financial assistance is available beyond the initial deposit. Contact Brett for additional information.
